LANTERN HILL.—A week or two ago we drew attention to the demolition of Lantern Hill, expressing our regret at the same time that such an interesting and picturesque landmark as the Hill and lighthouse should be in danger of destruction. Since then a petition, signed by the principal inhabitants of the town, has been presented to Sir B. P. Wrey, Bart., setting forth the peculiar attractions of the hill, and its popularity among the many visitors to this coast; and complaining that the excavations appear to be made to no other purpose than to procure materials to fill up the Harbour works, and thus to save the pockets of the Contractor. They therefore pray that he will use his influence to stay the work of destruction, while yet there is time. They acknowledge at the same time the great interest the honourable baronet had always taken in the welfare of the town. Should the request of the petitioners be granted, it is intended to form a Committee, and solicit subscriptions for the purpose of endeavouring to prevent any further landslips, by cementing the crevices of the rocks, &c. It is also proposed to cover the rugged surface of the rock with earth in which seed is to be sown. It is hoped by these means that the hill will be restored, in some measure, to its former green and pleasing appearance.
